Cleaning Products on Rosati Specialties UV System

Akzo Nobel is confirming that the Rosati Specialties UV coating system will stand up to normal regular cleaning with the following two cleaners as requested including normal application as well as a 1 (one) hour spot test:

- Clorox Cleaner with Bleach
- Lysol Disinfectants

Brill Finish

Cleaning on Brill Finish products

The following guidelines are focused on household settings and are approved for use by the general public when cleaning products finished with Axalta's Coatings.

- Cleaning refers to removal of germs, dirt and impurities from surfaces. It does not kill germs, but by removing them, it lowers their numbers and the risk of spreading infection.
- Use a 0.5% solution of a dishwashing soap designed hand washing dishes for cabinet and furniture components.
 - This process may be conducted on a daily basis.
- Disinfecting refers to using chemicals, for example, EPA-registered disinfectants, to kill germs on surfaces. This process does not necessarily clean dirty surfaces or remove germs, but by killing germs on a surface after cleaning, it can further lower the risk of spreading infection.
- Axalta recommends the use of a hand wipe such as Clorox Disinfecting Wipes. This product is listed on EPA List N and meets EPA's criteria for use against SARS-CoV-2, the virus that causes COVID-19. (EPA registration number 5813-79)
 - This process may be conducted on a periodic basis.
- Axalta does not recommend the use of bleach, alcohol or disinfectant cleaners which are applied by spray.

Laminate

Cleaning on Laminate

1. Isopropanol. Examples include: Purell Professional Surface Disinfectant Wipes, Klercide 70/30 IPA
2. Sodium Hypochlorite or Bleach. Examples include: Clorox Healthcare Bleach Germicidal Wipes, Ultra Clorox Regular Bleach 8.25%, Caviwipes)
3. Hydrogen Peroxides. Examples include: Clorox Commercial Solutions Hydrogen Peroxide Cleaner Disinfectant, Oxivir, Accel
4. Ammonia. Clorox Disinfecting Wipes, Lysol

Always follow cleaning or disinfectant with a warm rinse and dry.
